

**OFF-LICENCE**

Sections 29 and 114, Sale of Liquor Act 1989

PURSUANT to the Sale of Liquor Act 1989, Domain Road Vineyard Limited is authorised to sell or deliver liquor on or from the premises situated at 1 Leyden Terrace, Dunedin, and known as "Domain Road Vineyard", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of liquor on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Part 6 of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence will be subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No liquor is to be sold and delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day;
- (b) Liquor may be sold and delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Orders may be taken at any time on any day.**
- (c) The premises are undesignated.
- (d) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of liquor to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale and on the Internet web site detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (e) Order forms and Internet order screens must require customers to declare that they are over 18 years of age.

**THE LICENSED PREMISES**

In terms of Regulation 10 of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1990 the sale or delivery of liquor is authorised in or from the premises generally. The premises situated at 1 Leyden Terrace, Dunedin, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Dunedin District Licensing Agency on 19 November 2007.

**DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S**

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Leyden Terrace and the 'Domain Road Vineyard' internet website is designated as the principal entrance.

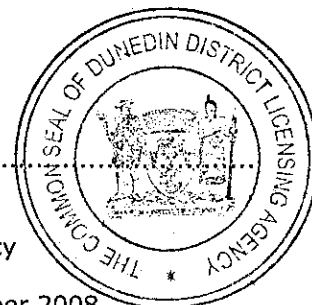
**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
